#### Excellency,

I would like to once again congratulate you on your recent election as the Speaker of Parliament of Iraq.

Noting that Parliament of Iraq has always been active in APA under your leadership, I wish to call on you to continue with the momentum and support for APA activities.

As the current term of APA Presidency is coming to an end soon, I would like to inform you that the procedure for nomination/election of the APA President is as follows:

- 1. Based on Article 11 of the APA Charter and Rule 11 of the APA Rules of Procedure, the President of the Assembly shall be elected from amongst the Presidents or Speakers of the Member Parliaments, for two years term, by acclamation or by the majority vote of the delegates present and voting, at the beginning of the first meeting of the Plenary, bearing in mind equitable geographical distribution.
- 2. Taking into account the balance in regional representation, priority should be given to the nominees of the underrepresented APA Regional Groups.

I may request you to positively consider APA Presidency.

The attached table, explains history of geographical distribution of the APA Presidents and Vice- Presidents, during last 15 years.

With due regard to a balance in regional representation, Asia is grouped into the following five sub-regions<sup>1</sup>:

- West Asia: Bahrain, Cyprus, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Palestine, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syrian Arab Republic, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, Yemen,
- **Southeast Asia:** Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor Leste, Vietnam
- South Asia: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Iran, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka,
- **East Asia and the Pacific:** China, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Kiribati, Mongolia, Palau, Republic of Korea, Tonga
- Central Asia and the CIS: Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russian Federation, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan
